

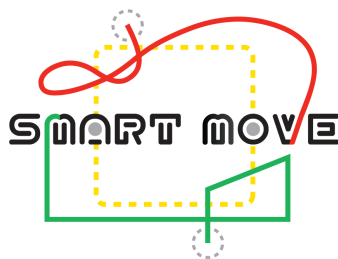

## FIRST LEGO League TASMANIA 2009



FIRST LEGO League (FLL) is an exciting and fun global robotics program that ignites an enthusiasm for discovery, science, and technology in students aged 9 to 16

Each year FLL teams embark on an adventurous Challenge based on current, real-world issues. Guided by a team coach and assisted by mentors, the kids will:

- Research and solve a real-world problem based on the Challenge theme (this year it is Transport)
- Present their research and solutions
- Build an autonomous robot using engineering concepts

Robotics Tasmania is offering a free 3 hour workshop for Teachers, Mentors/Coaches and other interested adults who are interested in preparing teams for the **Tasmanian FLL Tournament** (5<sup>th</sup> Nov at MacKillop College). No previous Robotics experience is necessary to participate in the workshop. We will be using NXT equipment and NXT-G software on the day.
