

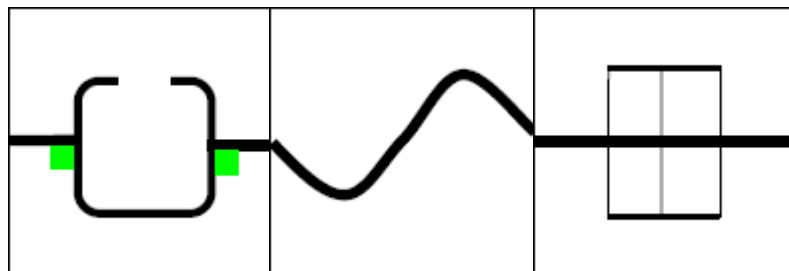

The RoboCup Junior Rescue and Premier Rescue challenges are a wonderful way to engage students in an open ended robotics activity. This is your chance to find out more about mentoring students (at both primary and secondary level) for this exciting robotics challenge.

Robotics Tasmania is offering a low-cost 3 hour workshop for Mentors, Teachers, and other interested adults. No previous Robotics or RoboCup Junior experience is necessary to participate. We will be using NXT equipment and NXT-G software on the day.
